



SECTION III: STUDENT POLICIES 3030

Computer Policy

Families with K-12 students will be offered one computer if they qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch. High school students will receive a laptop and students in grades K-8 will receive a desktop. Exceptions for hardships may be made by the Head of School using the following guiding principles:

1. Medical/health issues
2. Military-related cases of hardship
3. Disability of student or family member
4. Multiple students enrolled with OVCA
5. Hardship requests must be documented
6. Hardship exceptions are only valid through the end of the current school year. Families must request a new hardship exception each school year.

OVCA will not replace computers that are intentionally damaged or damaged due to negligence or misuse. Pursuant to the Agreement for Use of Instructional Property, families are solely liable for any loss or damage to the computer until it is returned to K12 and should take proper precautions to protect it. OVCA may require families to pay for lost or damaged computers.
